Manager's Mutterings

It has rained all day but it did not dampen farmers enthusiasm for coming to market to sell & buy stock.

Towards 500 cattle were sold today with 100% clearance of all being sold. Prices in all sections have increased. The prime cattle prices were noticeably up, with again quality cattle forward and peaking at 220p/Kg for a medium weight Limousin heifer from Ruth Holman of Shangton. I apologise to all farmers and buyers for keeping them waiting while we got cattle onto the weighbridge. We are making some adjustments to the system and the problem should be sorted for the next sale. Ben Shouler commented there was definitely a buzz around the ring and more confidence with the fat prices improving which had a knock on effect in the stores.

Tom reports an improved trade in all sections with buyers looking for quality Spring lambs under 43 kilos to achieve best results. Cull ewes also taking a real lift in price. An entry of ewes and lambs nearly as big as last week also saw an improvement in trade with some great prices achieved. Next week offers a chance to purchase show quality stock with an entry of ewes and lambs from David and Linda Wadland, an opportunity not to be missed!!

The Horse Sale on Saturday was a great success with 97 horses forward and 70 being sold. The top price being 1900 guineas or £1,995 for a 16.2h 8 year old Irish bay gelding.

Finally, in follow up to Leicester's confirmation as Premiership Champions last week, the Market was mentioned in the interview with Jamie Vardy in Hello Magazine. Our friends and market traders at Dickinson & Morris created this pork pie to mark the occasion.

Dear Customer,

Further to our recent consultations with you regarding the proposed changes to the layout of the Fur and Feather, Stalls and Farmers market, we would like to inform you of the process we intend to adopt, which we have changed slightly following your valuable feedback.

We will be installing a fence (marked red on the plan attached) which will separate livestock vehicles and market traders/ fur and feather customers.

A one way traffic system will be in operation until 9am, with stallholders, fur and feather and sundries auction customers entering the site through gate 1 on Scalford road, and leaving the site through gate 2, onto Scalford Road.

At 9am no more vehicles will be allowed on this part of the site, and those vehicles which are already on site will be required to leave.

The one way system will then reopen at 1pm, for vehicles to enter the site to remove their goods.

In the period between 9am and 1pm, the only vehicles which will be allowed on site will be those who have purchased items in the sundries auction and have a valid pass, which is to be collected from the office. These vehicles will enter and leave the site through gate 1.

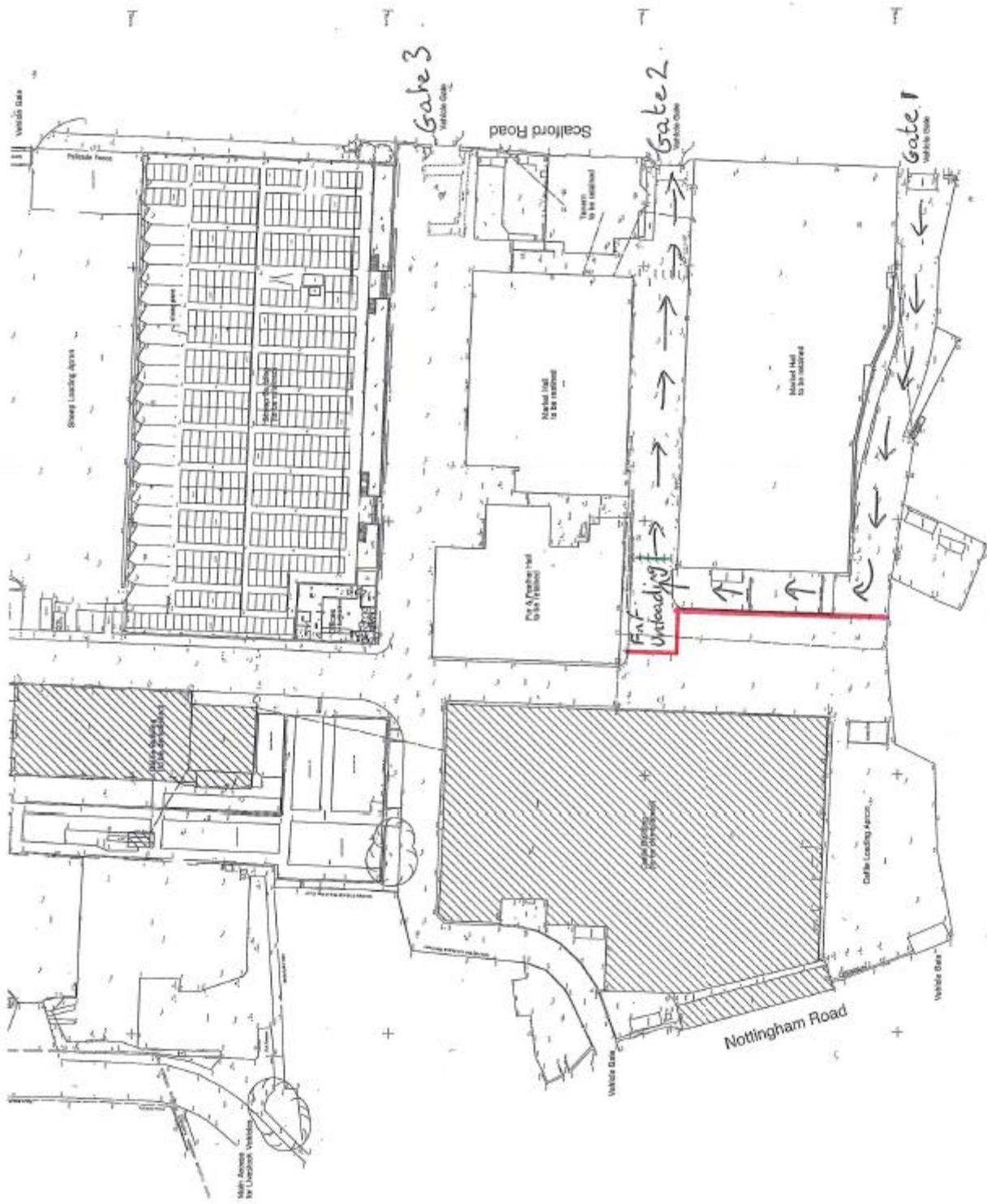
Pet auction customers will enter and exit the site through gate 3, as will fur and feather customers arriving after 9am.

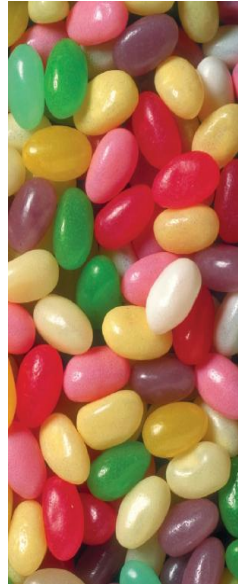

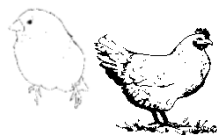
