## Chairman's Comments

Very much a day of two parts. Tom was very pleased that the entry of finished lambs was the largest since he started with us a year ago. Although trade is generally depressed due to factors outside our control (exchange rates, over-supply and religious fasting) our trade was as good as any other outlet and better than most.

Tim had a much increased entry with trade extremely buoyant. Our finished cattle section is growing strongly with more buyers present and payment on the day for all finished stock.

Our stand at the Royal Norfolk Show produced results with two very satisfied new clients selling finished cattle with us, rather than the deadweight system they previously used, with much better returns, a cheque in their pocket, and both bought calves to take home.

I said it was a day of two parts, the sombre side was that we learned of the passing of three stalwart supporters of the market over the weekend.

Most of you will have known Robert Green, who at one time was our largest buyer of finished lambs, and became a friend to many of us. Robert was a true professional in his field and was a great supporter of Melton Market. He has bravely fought crippling illnesses for the last 13 years, with good humour and courage. Our thoughts and prayers go to his wife Alison, son Ian, daughter Sarah and their families.

Most of our older customers will remember Jim Harrison from Retford, who was a valued client, especially in the 1990's when he sold significant quantities of breeding sheep with us. Again our thoughts are with his son David and his family.

Thirdly we learnt of the passing of John Reynolds from Woodhouse Eaves. Again a great supporter of the market, he always seemed to be cheerful, no matter how good or bad the trade was. Our condolences to his family.

I am away on holiday next week and hope I will have much better news to report on my return.

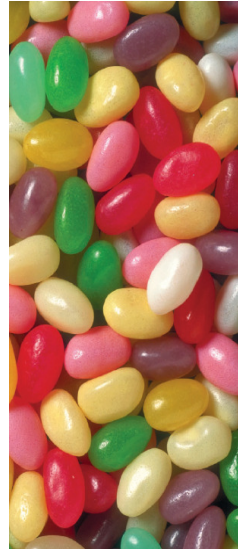

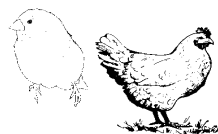
