I start with sad news at 5.00am this morning a good friend and a well respected Derby cattle auctioneer, Charlie Hollis passed away at home with his wife Maureen and family. A minute's silence around the fat cattle ring was respectfully observed. As soon as I receive funeral arrangements I will relay to you. Charlie would have been happy with today's trade. All keenly fought over and topping at 232p/Kg., for Jeremy Flint's Blonde heifer with a weight of 531kg to give a total price of £1,232. The race worked like clockwork and great credit goes to Richard Sharpe for making this happen. Myself and Hugh will be attending the National Beef Associations (NBA) Annual dinner, Thursday night at Buxton and then on to Beef Expo the following day at Bakewell with Tom. Love to see any of our customers there.

Store cattle today were firmer and with a good entry of 240 reared calves keeping the buyers & sellers happy.

Tom reports a trade which would exceed vendor's expectations in the fat with some dire reports from Monday. Another tremendous entry of ewes and lambs with over 1,100 couples passing through the market in three weeks. A fabulous run from David and Linda Wadland met strong demand, topping at £200 per life for a ewe with her single ram lamb.

On the subject of Derby market, we note the Council's lack of support there and the insensitive decision to announce its closure on Monday. This makes us all the more glad of the support we receive from Melton Borough Council with our new cattle building and 20 year lease. We wish Derby market operators every success in their challenge to the Council and remain ready to support them and their customers where we can.

One last note a big thank you to the Leicestershire and Rutland Young Farmers at the weekend at Twycross making myself, Tom and Ian most welcome at the event.

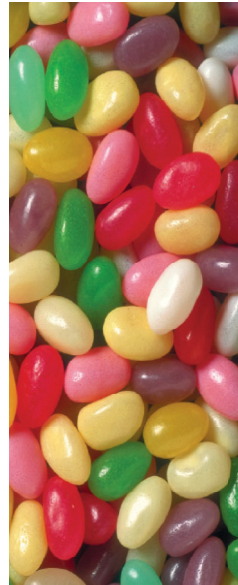
