## Shouler & Son

### BASIC PAYMENT SCHEME

The Greening rules for 2016 have been published.  
As previously, they mainly concern Farmers with arable land.  
The same features, as in 2015, can count:

*Buffer Strips*

*Catch & Cover Crops*

*Nitrogen-fixing Crops*

*Fallow Lane*

*Hedges*

As before, Fallow, including Temporary Grass counted as fallow, represents the simplest choice with the least scope for error.

Buffer strips and Hedges are the most complex, requiring careful attention, measurement and subjective judgements.

Catch Crops provide an interesting opportunity to return Permanent grassland to arable land. Also, undersown grass in the spring of 2016 can count as EFA catch & cover crops.

Early homework is advisable
