Freshly back from Majorca and feeling recharged, I would like to thank Simon Allam for keeping the fat trade going forward and was pleased with the prices achieved.

I seem to have brought the good weather back with me with temperatures soaring to the mid 30's so was no surprise less numbers throughout all cattle sections with farmers busy gathering their hay, silage, barley, etc.

Again good prices and weights were observed during the prime cattle sale with Horace Witcomb from Asfordby topping the market with the highest price of 238pp/kg for a Lim X Heifer, but also had the best grossing beast again a Lim X Heifer to £1484, it just shows weight does pay within the liveweight sector.

It was Ben's turn to have a relaxing break down to Cornwall and has again been lucky with the weather.

Barrie Williamson sold all sections of the store cattle. Though small in number prices were not affected with Gary Stevenson of Coleshill the highlight of the day with a bunch of 6 16mo Charolais Steers at £1120 a head.

Tom reports another good entry of prime lambs despite the sun. Although many expected trade to be a lot less, there was in fact a good trade for the meated lambs. Farm Assurance is making a difference at present with some abattoirs only taking from assured stock. 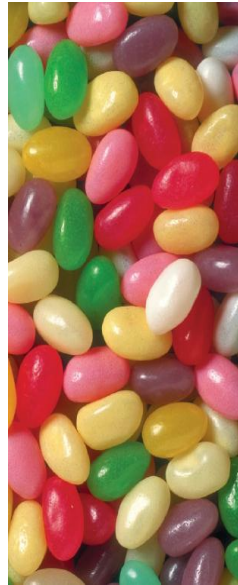
