As ever, Ben and Simon both seeing the benefits of strong fat trade with calves, reared and stores all phenomenal with only the usual complaint; more needed!

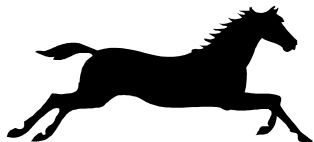
Richard's pig entry very strong, with this section growing sale on sale.

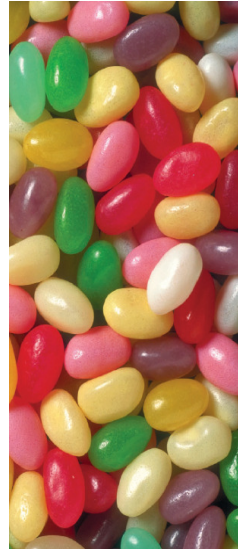

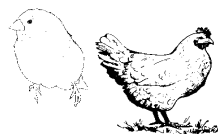
