It is good to be back and able to comment on today's market, having spent the previous weeks either at the Norfolk and Yorkshire Shows or spending a weeks holiday in Fuerteventura with the family.

Next week a great honour has been bestowed on me, I have been asked to judge at the famous Clogher Valley Agricultural Show in Northern Ireland, judging the commercial cattle classes, and looking forward to seeing a few old friends.

Enough about me, today we had more stock forward in most departments, this week especially in the Prime Cattle and Finished Lambs sections. Nearly 160 Prime Cattle forward with prices at a premium and have possibly peaked, but plenty of meat on offer with rows and rows of quality cattle and buyers very receptive.

Tom had over 1600 lambs forward and trade was better than predicted with all buyers present but restricted by price.

Ben had a good entry of reared calves with the trade very fast as always and topping at £945 for a continental steer from Moores Livestock of Kings Lynn.

Simon again had over 100 baby calves forward. This department gathering momentum with many new faces around the ring.

Richard Spendlove continues to sell the pigs and grows in confidence and stature each week. He has also been chosen to sell the pigs at the forthcoming Rare Breed Sale on 11th and 12th September.

While I was away Tom was able to attend the National Charolais Show at the NEC in Birmingham on the 8th July to present the awards, as Melton Market was the Charolais major sponsor.

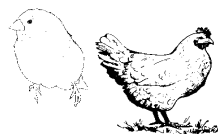
