Manager's Mutterings

Today's report starts with sad news of the death of one of my buyers Ray Edwards or 'Grandad' as he was known, who bought quality butchers' cattle for a few local firms. His son Andy took the reins and kept the name going. A minute's silence was observed impeccably from the ringside with droving and office staff in the ring.

I sold from a new rostrum in the fat today, which gave me a much better view of the cattle and buyers than previous weeks. Today there was plenty of weight about which bought the average down slightly but overall cattle in demand and selling well. The biggest beast of 827kg went for over £1,400, while 229p was the top price per kilo.

Both stores and the reared trade were excellent with many vendors promising more cattle for future weeks, which will be eagerly snapped up by the buyers.

Tom reports an increased entry of Spring lambs which were dearer, particularly those carrying plenty of meat. Buyers seem to be looking for 40-43 kilo lambs with plenty of lighter sheep on the market across the country.

This week we will be at the Lincolnshire Show, Wednesday and Thursday I invite you all to come and see us for a drink and meet the team. Also to an extended invitation the following week as we will be at the Royal Norfolk Show 29th & 30th June.

Work has now started on the Farmers Market roof and will continue over the next four weeks. There will be no disruption to the normal Tuesday offering, but for those coming to the Friday Market, the Farmers Market will be relocated to the Exhibition Hall. The main site building work progresses apace and we will be putting out further information in due course, but parking will continue to be tight and I would encourage customers to use the old Co-op pay and display parking on Scalford Road where possible.

Finally, as some of you may know, Stamford Animal & Pet Supplies (SAPS) are leaving their unit in the market. I would like to thank them for their custom over the years and wish Geoff & his team the best for the future. Customers will still be able to get their goods from the other suppliers at the market, who are ready to serve you.

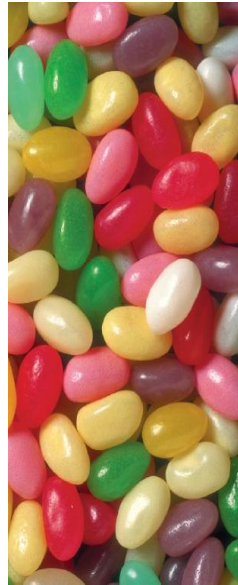
