## Manager's Mutterings

I start today's report by thanking Farmers Guardian for their kind invitation and fine hospitality last Thursday night at the National Beef Association (NBA) Annual dinner held in Buxton. Myself, Hugh and fellow auctioneers had a productive evening speaking to customers within our profession over a beer or two and were the last to leave the venue, thankfully not minding the quality of the hotel below. The next day we attended Beef Expo at Bakewell, where Tom joined us and it was good to speak to existing and potential new clients. We look forward to seeing many of you at the various shows over the summer, with the next one being the Rutland show on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June, which we are sponsoring.

Back to today's news, great optimism spreading week on week within the cattle departments, especially the prime stock with trade increasing again and a packed ringside of buyers eager to bid. The top price per kilo was 231p for a Blonde Aquitaine from Jeremy Flint of Stamford and the top total paid was £1400 for a Limousin x from C E Hardcastle & Son, Grantham. I have some quality cattle entered for next week already and would recommend others join them to meet the demand.

Store cattle remain strong with farmers wanting to fill up or increase their numbers. We have some quality 13-14 month old Angus named sire cattle entered for next week, which should be of interest.

Simon Allam's baby calves will be sold in a new/temporary ring next week to allow for works in relation to the new cattle building, but business as usual.

Tom reports a solid demand for new season lambs with competition for all weights.

A big thank you to all our customers for their understanding and co-operation with the traffic and parking restrictions as the building works commence on site. If you do find it difficult to park on site in busy times during this period, please be aware that the old Co-Op site on Scalford Road now operates a pay and display system with rates from 50p an hour.

One last point Charlie Hollis's funeral will take place on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> June at 11.00am at Marston on Dove Church, Derbyshire.
