Manager's Mutterings

September nearly over, and what a whirlwind of a month with Melton Market the hive of activity as well as boosting Melton's local economy, filling the town during our successful Horse Sale, Rare Breeds, NSA Ram Sale and Beer Festival.

October starts well with the Food Festival being held here over the weekend with many thousands of people expected to attend this. Tuesday is our Autumn catalogued Store Cattle Sale, approximately 400 entries already with entries closing on Thursday 1st October. Please contact myself on 07949 173180 for any more details or entries.

The fat cattle department, numbers a few less than expected, with many farmers making use of the fine weather, meeting strong demand. Prices were up again with a good show of quality, topping at 239p/Kg for Jonathon Thompson of Stainbys Limousin x heifer. Cattle are in particularly strong demand during these busy periods, and during good weather, if you need help bringing them to market I am more than happy to assist.

Tom reports a busy shed again, and with fat lamb trade taking a knock, a surprising amount of confidence among farmers. Store lamb, grazing ewes and breeding sheep a very good trade.

Last Friday's Farm Sale at Fawsley on behalf of H Griffin was a success with some excellent prices achieved across machinery and livestock. The livestock in particular, a real credit to Ted, and well rewarded for the quality. Thanks to all who came along.

Sheep commission

We provide a full service to our customers to market their livestock and charge a reasonable amount for doing so. We are currently reviewing our pricing model and we intend to implement changes across the market by the end of the year. Our principles in doing this are that our pricing will be fair, competitive, transparent and will encourage customers to bring more business to us through progressively lower charges, rather than any rise in commissions. As an interim step, we have made a reduction to our total sheep commission, by removing entry fees (effective from the last sale) and partially compensating with increased base commissions to 3.6% for fat sheep & stores and 5% for cull ewes (effective from next Tuesday). Existing volume related arrangements will be maintained pending the full review.

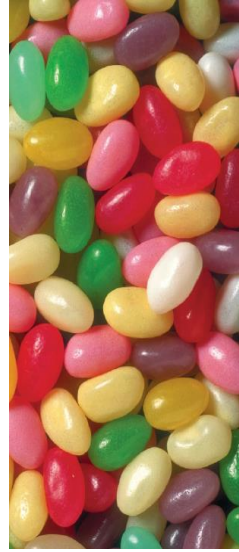
