We could learn much about the livestock market system in Ireland; not having passports, the movements to market are all done on a database, the 6 day standstill rule is interpreted different over there, with the standstill applying to only the livestock they bring on to the farm and not the whole herd, which I believe would and could make a tremendous difference to our current system. The only thing I do not agree with, there are no fat cattle auctions.

Enough politics, today the sheep trade was very buoyant with all buyers having orders to buy lambs as lorries could get across the channel into Europe. Tom is now moving on to the Store and Breeding Sheep Sales with the 18<sup>th</sup> August being the sale date for the Show and Sale of Breeding Ewes. Kindly sponsored by Charlotte Hobby of Ceva Animal Health. Further entries invited.

In my fat cattle department many farmers were missing, gathering their crops while the weather is set fair. The trade generated was very good with prices averaging well over £2 per kilo and pounds dearer than the deadweight system.

Ben Shouler sold all the stores today with Simon Allam resting after a busy Tuesday last week. Store prices show no sign of letting up and demand is great.

Please note all cattle must be accompanied with a cattle entry form. This is a compulsory requirement.
