Manager's Mutterings

Just recovering from a good show season with the Lincolnshire & Norfolk back to back, very tiring but worth every minute, speaking to new and old clients and friendly folk just wanting a chat. The staff input and dedication to marketing, catering and manning of these events was very much appreciated.

On the Friday after the Norfolk Show I was asked to attend the East of England show ground to take part in an education day for 6,000 primary school children on a Tesco sponsored day, teaching children healthy eating and where food comes from etc. My brief was to talk about cattle and have mock sales of mostly real livestock, but I had a back up of Hugo, a young lad doing work experience with us, dressed as a pantomime cow. It was a very rewarding day seeing the children bidding and also letting them have a go at auctioneering.

On to today's overview as I mentioned in my section report the prime cattle were a very good trade with many cattle well over what could be achieved on the deadweight system with cattle again grossing £1,500 + at Melton, you are getting weight and price which is a great combination.

Having seen Trevor Lyons with the commercial champion at Norfolk with a quality homebred Limousin heifer (incidentally the one I picked out at the Rutland Show) he entered a showy handy weight Charolais steer in today's auction and topped the market at 244p/Kg.

Barrie Williamson was about today meeting old and new farming customers in advance of Simon Allam passing his gavel over for Barrie's debut at Melton next week selling the rearing calves. It is not the end for Simon selling as he will be in the 'hot seat' selling the fat cattle as I am away to Majorca for a short break.

Store cattle prices remain serious, but with buyers still wanting more, as there is plenty of grass about.

Sheep numbers were up again this week with over 1,500 prime lambs reaching 215p/kg and £95 a head.

Our thanks to all our customers for their patience this week, with the new layout taking effect. Details can be found overleaf. We will also be looking to manage access through gate 3 better, which saw some congestion this week, with entry by permission only after 8:30am. 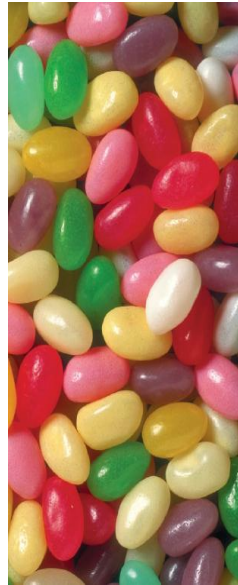
