Manager's Mutterings

I would like to start today's report with a big thank you to all our staff, family and friends who helped and ensured our presence at the Rutland Show on Sunday ran smoothly and well.

We met many customers over a drink during the hot conditions. I hope I did not upset too many farmers during my judging of the commercial cattle and picking Trevor Lyon's standout home bred Limousin heifer as the Champion. Our next show will be at Lincoln on the 22nd and 23rd of June. Please accept our invitation to come and join us.

Now on to today's mutterings the weather again was set hot and fine, keeping a few farmers away, though most had dropped off their stock and entrusted them to our capable hands and they would not be disappointed with good trade prevailing in all auctions.

The fat cattle had more numbers than expected but trade was good throughout and good to see new customers making the trip from the Derby area.

In the sheep department there was a wonderful quality of fat lambs forward today with the vast majority being well fleshed, with some very good Texel and Beltex x lambs forward, with a top price of £101 for a 44kg Texel. 12 buyers were present, although not all could buy enough sheep to fit their orders.

The better sheep, be they lambs or ewes were all wanted with buyers wanting quality to fulfil butchers' orders. FABBL is now becoming useful when selling fat lambs as supermarket buyers can only purchase Assured sheep. Today this would add £2-3 to the value of your lambs so is now worth considering

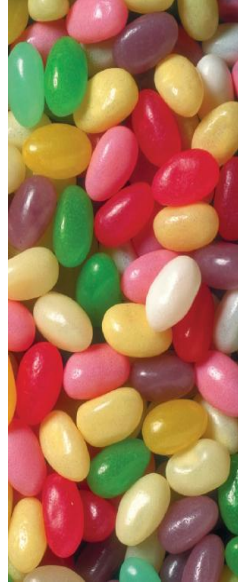
