Busy day at Market with over 4,000 sheep and 400 cattle sold today.

Prime lambs about holding their own but numbers coming out again. The breeding sale a particular success with a good clearance rate. Farmers are a little more cautious buying breeding sheep but quality still selling best. In the coming weeks some more nice consignments of breeding ewes coming our way. Entries will be kept up to date on the website.

Fat cattle prices continue to rise with more demand now for the beef with the Autumn weather, schools going back and annual holidays finished. Some of the cattle today were close to time and lacking finish; though good trade was maintained.

Store cattle are in demand as ever with many buyers around the ring. Entries are now being taken for our Autumn Cattle Sale on the 6th October. This is a catalogue sale and will commence at 12.30pm. Baby and reared numbers looked good today where a brisk trade was reported.

Our 13th Annual Show and Sale of Traditional and Native Rare Breeds is this weekend with a very good entry of cattle, sheep, pigs and poultry. Always a great spectacle, drawing many people from all regions of the British Isles. Where can you see all these rare breeds under one roof? A great event not to be missed. The show is this Friday with the sales on the Saturday.



Last Saturday our Horse Sale returned with an overwhelming success with 122 horses entered and crowds of people packed around the sale ring. Not a spare space to be had anywhere. For future Horse Sales at Melton, watch this space.

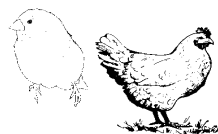
