A much better show of lambs, certainly in terms of quality. The French are on holiday which has conspired against the trade a little, but competition throughout for all weights, with some firms not able to really get going.

A top price per kg of 278ppk for IJ & PJ Handley, Ropsley and per head of £125 for WR Gill, Burton Lazars.

#### **Prime Hoggs (362)**

In general, really not a good show of meat this week. Mostly end of run sorts, with some exceptions, and quite a few with teeth up – all these left in the average. Trade firm enough throughout, although one or two firms focussing on lambs now. 7 buyers on as many accounts.

A top price per kg of 248ppk for MCB Thompson, Hallaton and per head of £152 for WR Gill, Burton Lazars.

#### **Cull Ewes (395)**

If anything, trade a little sharper provided they weren't over fat. Well fleshed ewes really touching the spot and receiving fantastic interest. Still a shortage of best ewes forward but a top price per head of £131 for B Worth, Leasowes.
