CONDITIONS OF SALE

All livestock is sold subject to the Conditions of Sale at Livestock Auction Markets, as recommended by the Livestock Auctioneers Association, and displayed in the Market Office.

All Heifers are sold to be free of the Bull unless otherwise stated. If any such animal is found to be in calf the purchaser must give notice, in writing, accompanied by a Vet's certificate to the Auctioneers within 6 months of date of purchase. The purchaser will then have the option of:

- Returning the disputed animal and receiving costs for keep at a fixed rate, carriage one way and Vets Certificate. **OR**
- Receiving 33% of the purchase price from the vendor as full and final settlement.

NO CLAIMS WILL BE MET UNLESS THE AUCTIONEERS ARE NOTIFIED PRIOR TO CALVING.

Movement Regulations

All livestock coming to market must be accompanied by a completed and signed licence (sheep) or an entry form (cattle).

Bovine TB Herd status and test dates **must** be included on all cattle entry forms.

Ear Tags

All cattle coming into market must be double tagged.

Payment

Purchases of stock are expected to be paid on the day unless otherwise agreed with the Auctioneer.

COMPULSORY CATTLE ENTRY FORMS

We would like to remind our customers of the importance of correctly filling out our Compulsory Cattle Entry Forms.

ALL cattle must be accompanied by a fully completed and signed entry form to include the TB testing interval and date of most recent test along with Farm assurance details and any reserves.

CATTLE WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT AN ENTRY FORM

FARM ASSURANCE STATUS

Would all cattle vendors selling cattle as Farm Assured, please ensure that their Farm Assurance is up to date, with all linked holdings registered to the primary holding, and ensure that the stickers used in passports match the details held by the administering Farm Assurance body.

We are increasingly having issues with linked holdings not being covered under a primary FABBL account, and **severe** deductions are being applied at the time of slaughter. In such instances, the vendor is liable for all deductions made.

Please tick the box on the entry form if you are Farm Assured, otherwise we will sell as Non-Farm Assured

WASHING OUT AT THE MARKET

A reminder to all bringing livestock to Market, you must wash out after unloading and before loading any more animals.

Bluetongue briefing – last update 17/11/24 – 11am

To all customers.

Last night (Saturday), the Restricted Zone (the "Zone") was extended to include more of Hampshire and part of Wiltshire. We are also now using our permission to sell breeding stock to buyers outside the Zone for the Winter Warmers sale next weekend and the facility is available for all sales where there is a dedicated breeding section, including weekly Tuesday and Wednesday sheep and cattle sales – please contact the office to find out more.

The zone now covers part or all of the counties and unitary authorities of Bedfordshire, Berkshire (part), Buckinghamshire, Cambridgeshire, City of Kingston upon Hull, City of York, East Riding of Yorkshire, East Sussex, Essex, Greater London, Hampshire (part), Hertfordshire, Isle of Wight, Kent, Leicestershire (part), Lincolnshire, Norfolk, North Yorkshire (part), Northamptonshire, Nottinghamshire, Oxfordshire (part), Suffolk, Surrey, Warwickshire (part), West Sussex and Wiltshire (part).

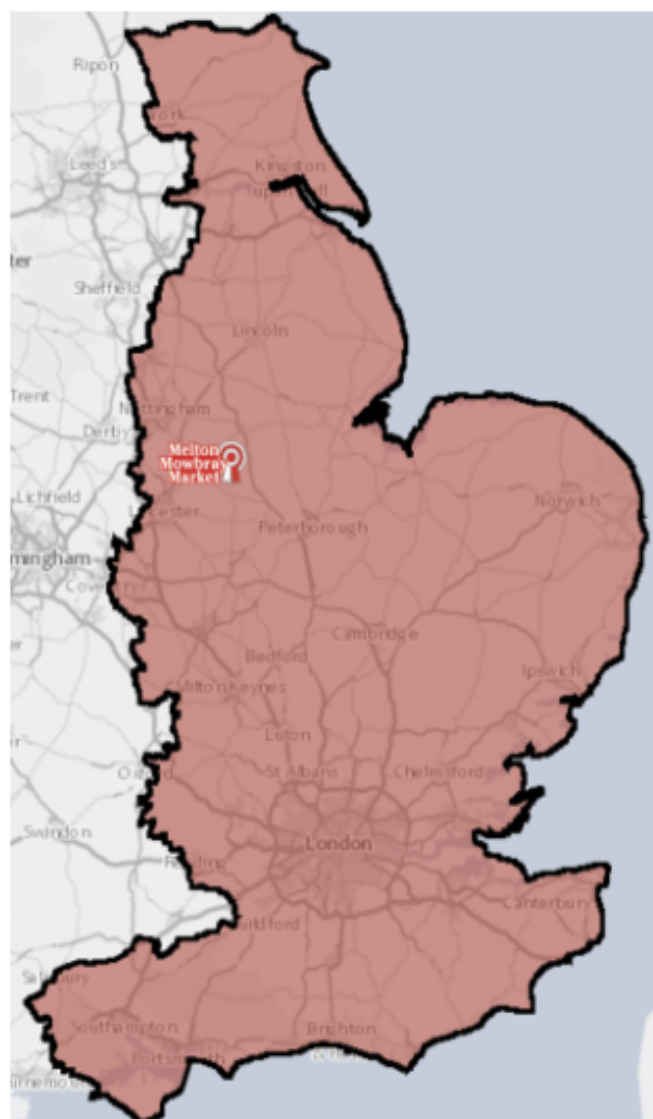
Being in the Zone, we can sell livestock from the whole country, without any special licences. However, we are only allowed to sell to buyers within the Zone, buyers for approved abattoirs outside, or buyers of breeding stock which has been pre movement tested (or is from outside the Zone) and will be post movement tested. For more details on the movement restrictions and free testing available, see below.

We are aware that some abattoirs from outside the Zone are refusing to handle stock from within the Zone, or imposing price penalties on stock sold. Rest assured that for stock sold through the Market, we will get you the best available price on the day from competing buyers. We are working hard with existing and new buyers to find more outlets for your stock and campaigning directly and through our trade association, the LAA, for greater freedom of trade for you (to reduce these penalties) as the temperature reduces and the virus becomes less able to replicate. If you are in any doubt as to what you can do, please message us and we will do our best to help you.

More detail on movement restrictions

- Free movement within the Zone (save for premises under restrictions)
- Free movement into the Zone from Markets or farms
- No movement without a specific licence is currently allowed **out** of the Zone unless direct to licensed slaughterhouse, licensed slaughter only (Red) market or for breeding stock into England only subject to pre (within 5 days of consignment to Market) and post movement testing (6-10 days after leaving the Market) through an approved market (which includes Melton)
